Objective: Filtering by Specialty in the People Listing.

Click Filter By. Select Specialty from the Dropdown. Type in the name of the Specialty. Click the Set Filter icon. Note: For more than one specialty, type "or" between the specialties. Your Listing now shows the filtered Specialties.
